2. An election to fill this vacancy will be held if, within 14 working days of the date of this notice, a request by 10 Local Government electors for the Parish Council area is received by the Returning Officer of Redcar & Cleveland Borough Council.

4. Any request received by the Returning Officer is available for inspection upon request.

Upon receipt of a valid request from 10 registered Local Government electors within the 14 working day period, an election will be held on 6 May 2021 in accordance with the terms of The Local Government and Police and Crime Commissioner (Coronavirus) (Postponement of Elections and Referendums) (England & Wales) Regulations 2020.
6. In the event that insufficient requests are received within the 14 working day period, the vacancy will be filled by the Parish Council by co-option.
